

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

FOR THE STATE OF WYOMING SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE 2011 CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that states receiving certain HUD funds prepare a Five Year State Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development (Consolidated Plan), a one-year Action Plan and an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. The State is preparing to develop a Substantial Amendment to the one year Action Plan for the State of Wyoming for 2011 funding in regard to the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). The State is providing and encouraging citizen participation.

The purpose of the Substantial Amendments are to describe program clarifications in the WRAP Program under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program, funded under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act, 2008 (HERA), as amended, also known as NSP1 and an additional allocation of funds provided under Section 1497 of the Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 (Dodd-Frank Act) also known as NSP3).

The NSP1 Substantial Amendment describes program specific information on NSP1 and more specifically it describes proposed budgetary reallocations and additional disposition options added under the WRAP program.

In order to allow the public to review the draft Substantial Amendment document for the NSP, the draft Substantial Amendment will be available on the WCDA website, www.wyomingcda.com, from Wednesday, September 21, 2011, through Wednesday, October 5, 2011. All public comments received will be posted on the website on October 6, 2011, as well as the final Substantial Amendment that will be submitted to HUD no later than October 6, 2011.
