

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

### FOR THE STATE OF WYOMING 2010 CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that states receiving certain HUD funds prepare a Five Year State Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development (Consolidated Plan), a one-year Action Plan and an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. The State is preparing to develop a Substantial Amendment to the one year Action Plan for the State of Wyoming for 2010 funding in regard to the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). The State is providing and encouraging citizen participation.

The purpose of the Substantial Amendment is to describe additional eligible activities being proposed under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program, funded under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act, 2008 (HERA). The Substantial Amendment will also describe other actions the state intends to take under the direction of the NSP program during the next year.

The Amendment will describe Program specific information on the Neighborhood Stabilization Program.

In order to allow the public to review the draft Substantial Amendment document for the NSP, the draft Substantial Amendment will be available on the WCDA website, [www.wyomingcda.com](http://www.wyomingcda.com), from Thursday, January 14, 2010, through Friday, January 29, 2010. All public comments received will be posted on the website on February 1, 2010, as well as the final Substantial Amendment that will be submitted to HUD no later than February 5, 2010.

- **A public hearing will not be held on the substantial amendment.
