1. Eligible Applicant

2. Eligible Activity

- Public/non-profit infrastructure: acquisition, design, construction, renovation
- Local programs assisting LMI: housing rehab, services, shelters
- Limited planning and capacity building

3. National Objective:

Principally Benefits Low- and Moderate-Income Persons
Alternatives - Addresses slum or blight; or urgent need

Low- and moderate-income (LMI) is 80% of median household income by family size as calculated by HUD.

4. Compliance with CDBG/federal requirements

- Project **cannot** be under construction
- Project **must** undergo an environmental review prior to construction
- If property was acquired or converted with impacts to tenants, project must STOP to meet acquisition/relocation requirements
- Procurement and federal/state prevailing wage requirements apply
- If job creation, hiring agreements and job reporting apply

5. Timing of funds

- Award contingent on availability of federal funds
- Agreement must be executed within 90 days of award
- Other project funding and partnerships must be secured before CDBG contract execution
- Project must have release of funds issued and a notice to proceed to start
