Rental Affordability:

According to the U.S. Census' ACS, **4,571** renters in this area were cost burdened (paying more than 30% of their income towards rent) between 2017-2021.

Of those renters, **18.62%** were over the age of 65. Additionally, **38.72%** of cost burdened renters earned less than \$20,000 between 2017-2021.

Endnotes:

¹ Gross rent is defined by the U.S. Census Bureau to be the contract rent plus the estimated average monthly cost of utilities (electricity, gas, water and sewer) and fuels (oil, coal, kerosene, wood, etc.) if these are paid by the renter (or paid by the renter for someone else). Gross rent is intended to eliminate differentials that result from varying practices with respect to the inclusion of utilities and fuels as part of the rental payment.

Calculations presented here were performed by staff at PolicyMap and are based on estimates from the U.S. Census' American Community Survey for 2017-2021. Reports at a zip code level will be substantially incomplete as Census does not capture data for these indicators at a zip code.

For custom areas such as custom regions, school districts, and political districts, Census data was calculated by summing the following Counties in 2017-2021: **Laramie**.
